- 1. In order to improve master's program/doctoral program student understanding of research ethics, National Tsing Hua University (hereinafter referred to as "NTHU") establishes the National Tsing Hua University Directions for Implementation of Academic Research Ethics Education Courses (hereinafter referred to as the "Courses").
- 2. Any master's program/doctoral program students admitted since academic year for 2015 (inclusive) shall attend the Courses before the end of their first academic year after the admission.
- 3. The Courses shall be implemented online and are required courses generating 0 credits. Students who attend the Courses shall pass tests successfully, or they shall try to pass tests before applying for the degree examination at the latest. Students who fail to complete the Courses successfully are not allowed to apply for the degree examination.
- 4. The Directions shall be implemented upon approval of the University Curriculum Committee and approval and recordation by a faculty meeting.
