

National Tsing Hua University Directions for Guidelines for Outstanding Graduation Academic Performance Award for Bachelor's Program

Established at the 5th Faculty Meeting for Academic Year 2020 on June 10, 17 and 28, 2021

Approved by the President on July 12, 2021

1. The Directions have been adopted to reward the graduates of the Bachelor's Program who have excelled in the Bachelor's Program and can be identified as role models for undergraduates at National Tsing Hua University (NTHU).
2. Number of seniors to be awarded: Based on the number of students in each department, class, group or degree program, the proportion is 5% (rounded) of seniors enrolled in the next semester of the academic year in the NTHU database. The number of students to be awarded will be notified by the Registrar Section. Early graduates in the first semester of the current academic year or the second semester of the previous academic year are entitled to the reward if Point 3 is met.
3. Eligibility - one of the following must be met:
 - (1) Seniors with a cumulative GPA of 3.4 (inclusive) or higher up to the first semester of their senior year and who meet the academic performance standards set by their respective department, class, group, or degree program.
 - (2) Early graduates who graduate in the first semester of their senior year or the second semester of their junior year with a GPA of 3.4 (inclusive) or higher and who meet the academic performance standards set by their respective department, class, group, or degree programs.
 - (3) Those who have been approved by a department, class, group, or degree program due to special circumstances.
4. The list of recommended recipients from each department, class, group, or degree program is sent to the Registrar Section after approval by their respective Director and Dean.
5. Award: A certificate and an honorary cravat, given to each department, class, group, degree program or institution before the graduation ceremony.
6. "Graduated with Distinction" will be added to the student transcripts of the recipients.
7. The Directions shall be enforced upon approval of the Faculty Meeting and authorization by the President.
